

## Section 5

## Caleb's Peak Access Purple Trail

Difficulty: Easy to Moderate



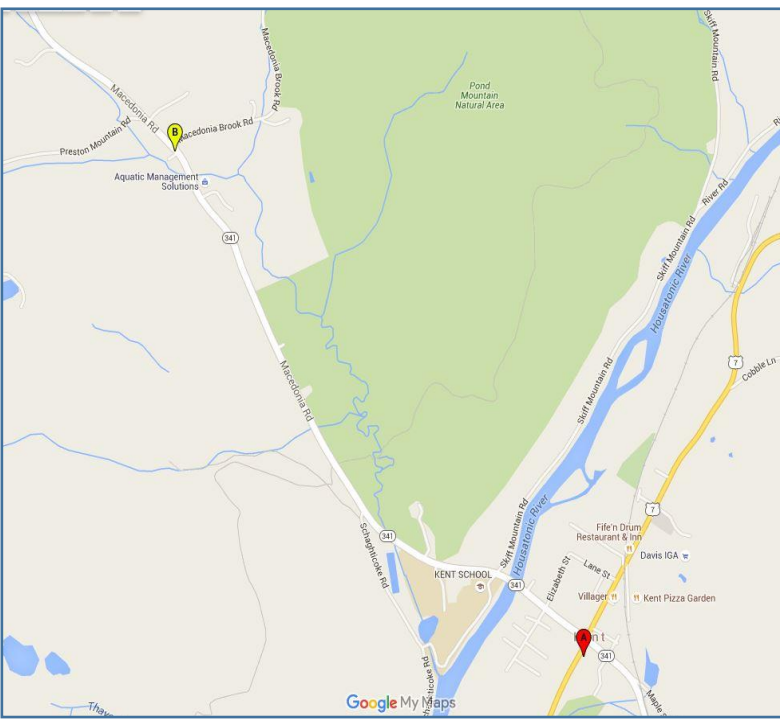
The Purple trail off of Skiff Mountain Road leads to Caleb's Peak, where it joins with the longer official Caleb Peak Appalachian trail blazed with White blazes. The trail ascends through a forested area a short distance to Caleb's Peak where a beautiful view of the town of Kent awaits you. There are plenty of "sitting" rocks, so bring a picnic or snack and enjoy the view. Ceruleans were recently discovered two minutes up the trail from the parking area!

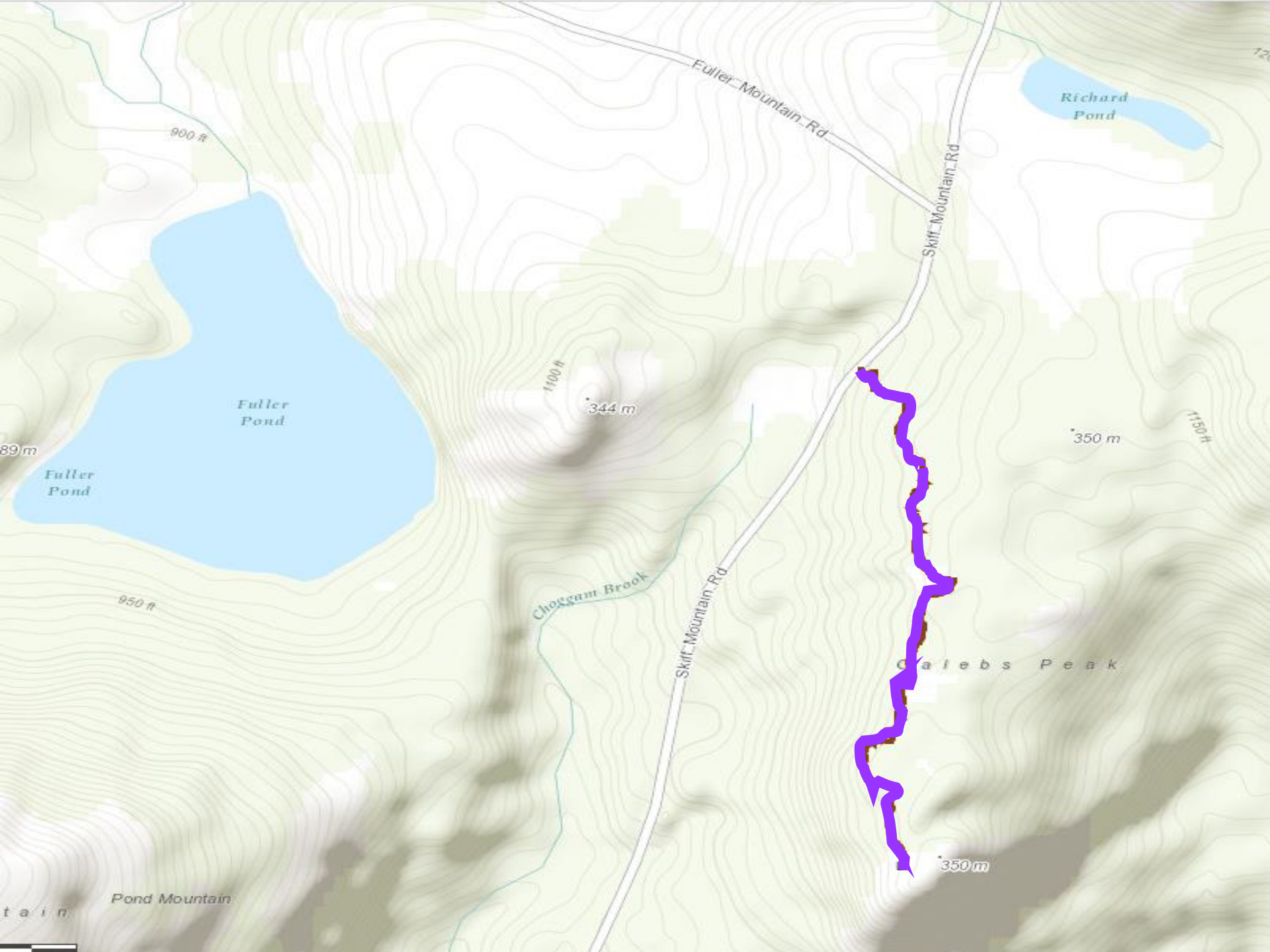
Total Mileage – ~1.3 miles round trip

## DIRECTIONS

### From Route 7 in Kent (Monument and Patco Gas Station):

- From Route 341 west in Kent
- Cross the bridge over the Housatonic and turn right onto Skiff Mountain Road.
- Turn right on the dirt road by the river. Skiff Mountain Rd continues up the hill
- In ~3.5 miles you will come to a parking area turnout on the right. Park here. Note: If you pass Fuller Mountain you have traveled too far.
- Park here, locate the Purple blazes slightly south of the parking area and start hiking.
